Bismarck Dream Center to Receive Partnership Building Award

BISMARCK – The Bismarck Dream Center is the recipient of the 2025 North Dakota Association of Nonprofit Organizations' (NDANO) Partnership Building Award.

The Partnership Building Award is given to an organization that has demonstrated community leadership and built partnerships within the North Dakota nonprofit sector.

Since opening its doors in April 2022, the Dream Center has become a cornerstone of hope and support in the Bismarck-Mandan community, providing over one million meals just last year alone. With a mission rooted in partnership, the Dream Center opens its space free of charge to organizations that share its commitment to helping others. Each day, more than 500 guests find not only a hot meal, but access to critical services offered by partners like ND Job Service, Northland Health, Burleigh County Health, Bridging the Dental Gap, Alcoholics Anonymous, Celebrate Recovery, Memory Café, and NDSU Extension's parenting and cooking classes. Through this model of collaborative outreach, the Dream Center has helped drive life-changing transformation for families across the region. Its leadership and innovative approach to nonprofit partnership have made a lasting impact, not only in its immediate community but across North Dakota's nonprofit sector.
